## *Cristo Sana Casa Misionero*

Last April, Christ the Healer Medical Mission opened the doors to **Cristo Sana Casa Misionero** (Christ the Healer Missionary House). Fr. Jimmy Jeanfreau worked in collaboration with Bishop Solorzano of the Diocese of Granada to have the building renovated for future endeavors. The building contains a large room and waiting area for the Eye Clinic and living quarters for the lay mission program. The facility will have a year round caretaker provided by the Diocese of Granada.

While on mission in Granada in

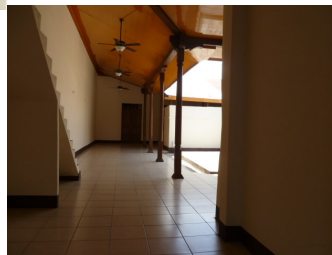
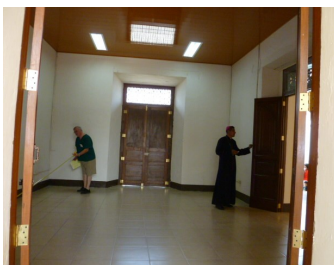
April, David Munn, and some locals relocated the temporary eye clinic from the Women's Clinic to its new location.

## Non-Medical Missioners
