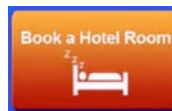

Meibomian Gland Dysfunction, anteroplacement and thickening of Line of Marx, and Blepharitis are common conditions seen daily in the optometric practice. This course will review the prevalence, diagnosis, and then focus on in-office treatments options for each.

It will look at MMP9 as a marker for inflammation, and provide guidance on how to evaluate MMP9 in patients. It will also touch on osmolarity as a marker of DED.

Dry Eye Disease DED can be overlooked as a cause of vision challenges. The quality of the tear film plays a large role in the clarity of vision, and should be evaluated. This course will explore evaluation of tear film quality and provide recommended protocols for DED diagnosis. It will address common misperceptions regarding DED.
